## RESOLUTION OF THE NOTIFICATION NO. MATS/2025/REG/07:

Prof. (Dr.) K. P. Yadav – Vice-chancellor has presented a comprehensive proposal for the approval of Study Learning Materials (SLMs) developed for various Open and Distance Learning (ODL) programmes under the aegis of the MATS Centre for Distance and Online Education (MCDOE).

In his presentation, Prof. Yadav emphasized that the development and deployment of high-quality SLMs is a cornerstone of effective ODL delivery, significantly influencing learner engagement, conceptual understanding, and academic achievement. The Academic Council was apprised that the SLMs have been developed strictly in accordance with the norms and standards prescribed by the University Grants Commission - Distance Education Bureau (UGC-DEB) Regulations.

The materials have been designed to be pedagogically robust, self-contained, and learner-centric, integrating print, digital, and multimedia elements where appropriate. These features are aimed at enhancing accessibility and independent learning. The following programmes were covered under the SLM development initiative:

Additionally, the Council noted with appreciation that systematic provisions have been made for content localization and translation into regional languages, ensuring inclusivity and wider reach. A periodic review mechanism has also been instituted to keep the content contextually relevant and updated in alignment with national curriculum frameworks and emerging academic trends.

The Academic Council unanimously approved the Study Learning Materials (SLMs) for the aforementioned ODL programmes. The Council also placed on record its deep appreciation for the academic and technical teams involved in this significant endeavour. The Council commended the quality, comprehensiveness, and learner-centric design of the SLMs and acknowledged the initiative as a progressive step towards enhancing the academic integrity and outreach of MATS University's Distance education offerings.
