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Declaration on Same Pass or Fail Criteria

This is to certify that all the programmes offered under the Open and Distance Education Mode by the MATS University, Raipur, follows the same Pass or Fail Criteria as prescribed for the Conventional (Regular) Mode.

The minimum passing marks, grading system, internal and external assessment components, and overall evaluation standards are identical in both modes. These are governed by the **Examination and Evaluation Ordinance** of the University applicable to all programmes, irrespective of the mode of delivery.

This parity ensures consistency in academic standards and is maintained in accordance with the UGC (Open and Distance Learning Programme and Online Programme) Regulations, 2020.

##As per the MATS University's Ordinance – 144 (Gazetted on 03rd September, 2024), the details of the Examination, Evaluation and Assessment components as follows:

Point No. 26: Examination and Evaluation

Evaluation shall be based oncontinuous assessment, in which sessional work and the terminal examination shall contribute the final grade. Sessional work shall consist of class tests, mid-semester examination(s),homework assignments, etc., as determined by the faculty in charge of the courses of study. Progress towards achievement of learning outcomes shall be assessed using the following: time-constrained examinations; closed-book and open-book tests; problem-based assignments; practical assignment laboratory reports; observation of practical skill

s;individualprojectreports(case-studyreports);teamprojectreports;oralpresentations, including seminar presentation;viva voce interviews;computerizedadaptive assessment,examinationon demand,modular certifications, etc.

- 26.1 The academic performance of a candidate shall be evaluated in respect of the courses of study prescribed for each semester through the evaluation. The evaluation of students admitted in the programme shall be based on
 - 26.1.1 End Semester Examinations 70% marks of total marks and
 - 26.1.2 Continuous Internal Assessment 30% of total marks



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- 26.2 The End Semester examinations shall be held as per the academic calendar notified by the University and the duration of end semester examination shall be of three or two hours.
- 26.3 The minimum percentage of marks to pass the programme in each semester shall be 40% in each course comprising of end semester examinations and continuous evaluation.

Point No. 29: LetterGradesand GradePoints

The University may also mention marks obtained in each course and a weighted average of marksbasedon marksobtainedinall thesemesterstakentogetherfor thebenefit of students.
